  - Supporting the development of a positive culture and climate in all schools throughout the district.
  - Adapting, revising, or replacing (where needed) policies, procedures, and operating guidelines, especially in the area of student discipline.
- 4. Established a multitiered systems of support (MTSS) process at the district and school levels to ensure equitable access to educational opportunities for all students.
- 5. Provided supports for staff through the development of an ongoing professional development plan with specific training targeting social, emotional, and character development, and related topics.
